AGM HIGHLIGHTS

On April 6, 2010, we held our **61st Annual General Meeting** at London's Best Western Lamplighter Inn. The meeting was chaired by Kim Darling, the LCECU Board Chair. During the meeting, the members reviewed and approved the proposed changes to the credit union's By-Laws, which primarily dealt with conforming to recent changes in the Credit Unions and Caisses Populaires Act and Regulations that took effect on October 1, 2009.

Kim Darling reported some of the more significant events of the year, which included the addition of Kathryn Bezzina as Youth Advisor to the Board, and the significant growth in member deposits, loans and profits. The membership was also informed that in 2010 the credit union was going to be focusing on growing membership, our youth, branding and marketing and that a consultant was being hired to assist the credit union in this critically important undertaking. As a result of the positive results, the credit union returned \$27,600 by way of patronage rebates and interest to the members.

Audit Committee Chair Nancy Hindmarsh reported on behalf of the Audit Committee and Jim Morton reported on behalf of the Corporate Governance Committee. Jill Regan presented the loans report and CEO Lew Figol updated the members on many accomplishments undertaken by the credit union in the past year and also welcomed the new membership group from GM Diesel and Electromotive.

Elected to three year terms were Kim Darling, Sherry McEvoy and Richard Kemp. Immediately after the AGM, the Board of Directors re-elected Kim Darling as Chair and Nancy Hindmarsh as Vice Chair.
